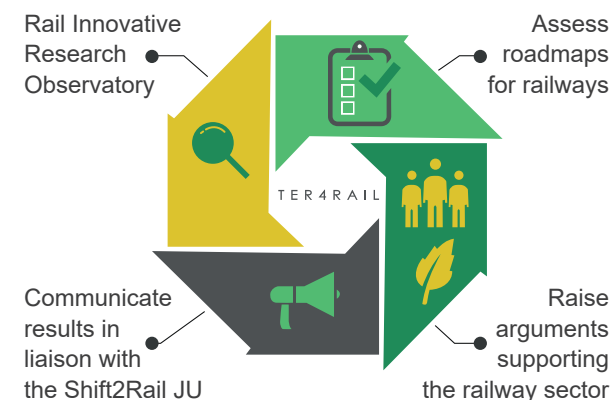

### TER4RAIL Key outputs

The work of TER4RAIL is organised as follows:

- TER4RAIL identifies and monitors new opportunities for innovative research and facilitates the cross-fertilisation of knowledge from other disciplines, at what is referred to as the Rail Innovative Research Observatory.
- TER4RAIL determines and assesses the existing roadmaps that drive the future of railways and compares them with the interpretations obtained from the observatory.
- TER4RAIL considers railways as the backbone of future European mobility and will therefore raise arguments (using data analysis and statistical reporting) to support this statement.
- TER4RAIL selects and synthesises a considerable amount of information regarding railways' futures and transmits them to the transport sector in a consolidated, improved, clear, and understandable manner.

THE TER4RAIL PROJECT INTENDS TO PROMOTE KNOWLEDGE AND INFORMATION TRANSFER BETWEEN RAIL STAKEHOLDERS AS WELL AS THE INCORPORATION OF INNOVATIVE IDEAS FROM OTHER DISCIPLINES. TO ACHIEVE THAT, A FOUR-PILLAR PLAN HAS BEEN OUTLINED.
